6. Final approval to start School of Pharmacy and School of Law would be granted by the UGC.
7. A review of the deemed to be University would be conducted by the UGC as per UGC (Institutions deemed to be Universities) Regulations, 2016.
8. Continuation of deemed to be University status is granted by the MHRD.


