MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING – AGREEMENT

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) was made at Tiruchirappalli on
13.02.2019 between PG And Research Department of Botany, Holy Cross College

Crescent Institute Of Science And Technology, company located in Chennai.

Holy Cross College (Autonomous) Tiruchirappalli has been in the forefront of women's education for nine and a half decades, and one among the oldest colleges for women in South India. It was started for the benefit of the young girls of Tiruchirappalli as early as 1923 by the Sisters of the Cross of Chavanod, Province of Tiruchirappalli, affiliated to the Bharathidasan University. It was recognized by UGC as "College with Potential for Excellence". As per the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) by MHRD, Government of India, the College was ranked 26th and 46th for the years 2017 & 2018 respectively.

The Department of Botany was established in 1935 to offer B.Sc. Degree in Botany under affiliation of University of Madras. In 1964, it became one of the pioneer PG Departments. It started M. Phil. Course in 1982 & Ph. D. programme in 1991 under the affiliation of Bharathidasan University. The title of the PG Botany was changed to Botany with Specialization in Plant Biotechnology in 2002. The Department is a proud recipient of funds from DST – FIST and DBT – Star College Scheme since 2008 and 2010 respectively. The Department stands for its academic excellence, development of research skills and extension potentials. Department encourages creative skills of students and helps them in transforming into reality years hereinafter called "Holy Cross College" of the FIRST PART

B.S. Abdur Rahman Crescent Institute of Science and Technology, Vandalur, Chennai 600 048, a deemed to be university established under Section 3 of the UGC Act 1956, having its location at Seethakathi Estate, GST Road, Vandalur, Chennai 600 048, involved in providing quality education, research and extension activities for over 34 years hereinafter called "Crescent" of the OTHER PART

SCOPE OF THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

To promote co-operation between Holy Cross College (Autonomous) Tiruchirappalli – 620 002, Tamil Nadu, India and B.S. Abdur Rahman Crescent Institute of Science and Technology, Chennai, India, hereby accept to enter into this agreement for promoting academic and research related activities between the two.

1. The two Institutions shall encourage direct contact between their faculties, administrators, departments, schools and research centres in order to promote this co-operation.
2. Within the areas that are mutually acceptable, cooperation will be pursued in:
 - a. **Joint research**
 - b. **Exchange of faculties for research, teaching and collaboration**
 - c. **Exchange of students for study and research**
 - d. **Exchange of information including, but not limited to exchange of library materials and research publications which is of mutual interest to both**

- e. Access to various research facilities of the institutions by the collaborating faculty and students, and joint publications
- f. For each area of work (Project to Project) under the above said cooperation, a separate detailed agreement shall be executed covering the title; scope; roles and responsibilities; IPR related; investments involved; ownerships; sharing of revenues; etc.,

Implementation

This agreement comes into force on the day when representatives of the two institutions affix their signatures, and is valid for three years. The institutions agree to review it after three years from the date hereof.

The notice of termination of this MoU needs to be given six months in advance by either side. Any change to this MoU shall come into effect only after the changes are written and signed by both the parties.




