PREAMBLE



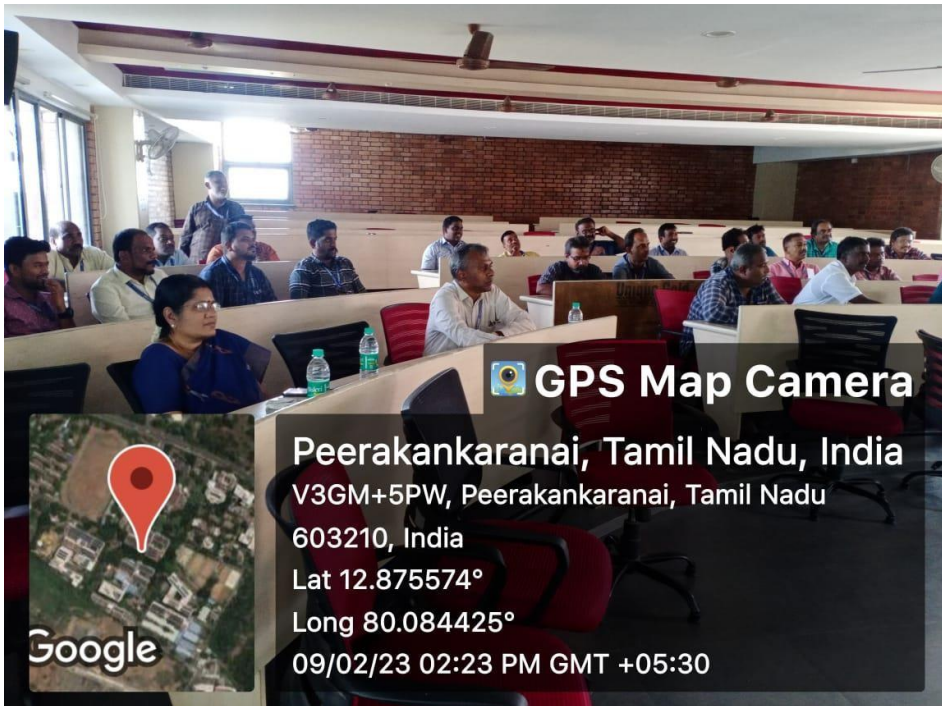
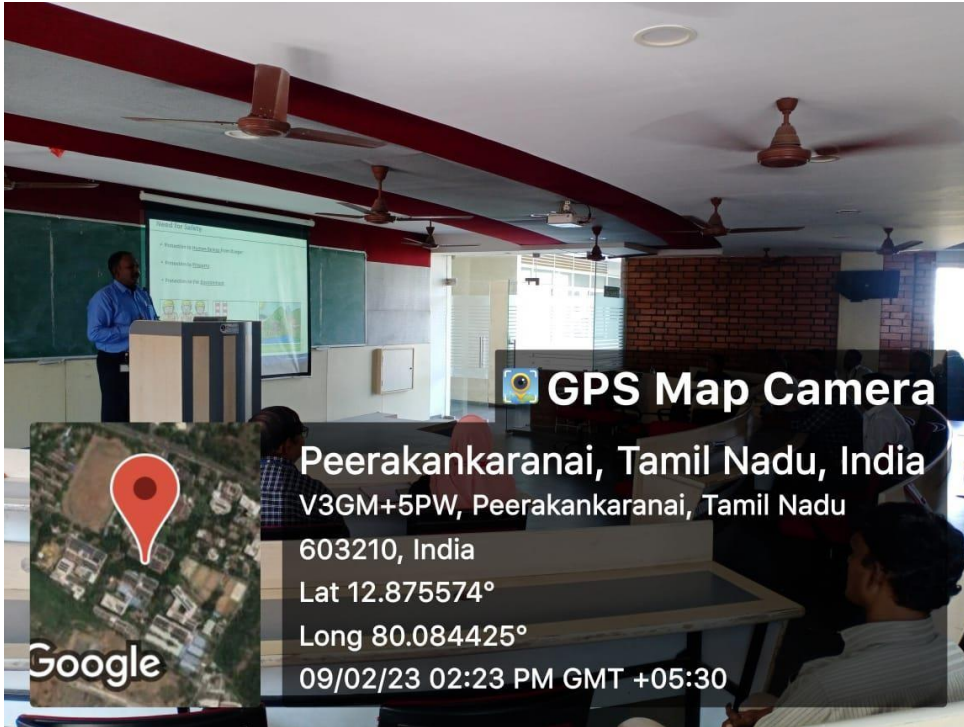
The flyer with the information about the seminar was designed and circulated to all the non-teaching technical staff in the various departments of the University . The seminar flyer is given below:
