





I. Online activities


Webinar attended.




WEBINAR ON HEALTH AND HYGIENE ON WOMEN ON 3RD SEPTEMBER 2020

AWARENESS WEBINAR ON PREVENTION AND CONTROL OF COVID 19 – 28.12.2021

The NSS units of Crescent Institute of Science and Technology have conducted a Awareness programme on prevention and control of Covid 19 on 28-12-2021 02.00 PM. ThiruC.MariaArputhaSamy, District health educator was the resource person in the event DrDr.D.Ayub Khan Dawood, NSS Coordinator BSACIST Welcomed and introduced the speaker. The Session was for 2 hrs.

ThiruC.MariaArputhaSamy explained in detail regarding the symptoms and prevention of COVID-19. Dr. Saud explained that Corona viruses are family of viruses that can cause illness such as the common cold, severe acute respiratory syndrome (SARS). He informed that the common sign and symptoms can be fever, cough and tiredness. Early symptoms of COVID-19 may include a loss of taste or smell.

Speaker explained that people above the age of 60 have a higher risk of serious illness from COVID-19, and the risk increases with age. Thirusamy also educated the preventive measures for COVID-19 that we should maintain social distance, wash hand with soap and water frequently or use alcohol based hand sanitizer that contain at least 60% alcohol, Cover face with a cloth mask face in public, Stay home avoid going to public places.
